How we made these updates

This new UI is a theme built on top of Lightning Design System. We updated the look and feel just by modifying styling hooks (CSS properties).

These are the styling hooks used to update the UI.

css Property	Figma Property
background-color	Fill
border-color	Stroke
color	Fill
border-radius	Corner Radius
box-shadow	Effects / Drop shadow
font-scale	Font size in pixels
font-weight	Font weight (Light, Reg, Semi, and Bold)
spacing	Padding
sizing	Fixed height and fixed width







Consistent components from design to code


Look for the library in Figma by clicking the **Assets** tab in the upper left corner of the app. Then click the **Libraries** icon.
